This annual event serves to remind all of us of the tragic past and the victims of the Japanese Army atrocities committed during World War II. In a short six to eight weeks in the winter of 1937, the Japanese Imperial Army raped, massacred, and maimed more than 300,000 innocent civilians in Nanjing, China. Today, despite the urging of human rights activists in Japan, Asia, and the world, the Japanese government under Prime Minister Shinzo Abe continues to deny or minimize history and refuses to offer a official national government apology or accept responsibility for its misdeeds to this day.

To honor the victims, and to pursue justice and an enduring regional/world peace, we sincerely invite you to join the worldwide Chinese community to commemorate the anniversary of this historical event which has been designated by the National Congress of the People's Republic of China as the "National Mourning Day."
